

Vietnam became Part of French Indochina

Vietnam, ruled by the vietnamese NGUYEN Dynasty, was divided in 3 protectorates (Tonking, Annam and Cochinchina).

Along with Laos and Cambodia, Vietnam became part of the French Indochina 1858 - 1945



**1940 – 1945: French Indochina was ruled
by France
under co-government of Japan.**



French troops defeated at the Dien Bien Phu battle in 1954.

Vietnam consequently was divided in 2 parts.

The victorious communist Viet Minh controlled North Vietnam.

South Vietnam, governed by the last Vietnamese king of the Nguyen dynasty, remained under French influence.




Landing of US troops in Da Nang on March 8th 1965










Outcome of Patients much comparable to Western Institutions



Surgical vs **catheter interventional**






